Introducing the "Anneliese Sinn Arts Fund"

A woman of unusual vision, Anneliese Sinn, PhD established the art therapy program at Eureka College at a time when the profession was just beginning to organize itself in the United States. She passionately believed in the power of visual arts to serve therapeutic ends and she fostered numerous field experiences for art therapy students in educational and mental health settings. The fund will provide support for performing, visual and fine arts projects, as well as art education and art therapy initiatives. Priority will be given to projects and initiatives that serve children and/or those with special needs or disabilities. Sinn established the fund through her estate and it will be part of the 2020 Community Arts grant cycle.
