The Community Foundation of Central Illinois Awards \$69,825 for Local COVID-19 Relief Efforts

June 3, 2020 – Peoria, IL: The Community Foundation of Central Illinois (CFCI) is pleased to announce the second round grant recipients of the Central Illinois Disaster Recovery Fund. CFCI received 27 applications and was able to fund 14 organizations, including \$10,000 going to the Heart of Illinois United Way to further support their grantmaking related to COVID-19. These grants will provide flexible financial support to nonprofit partners within the CFCI service area, who are responding to increasing needs as a result of COVID-19.
